FATALITY AT CAPE TOWN CONTAINER TERMINAL

[20 March 2020 – Cape Town] – A 52 year-old truck driver collecting a container at the Cape Town Container Terminal (CTCT) was fatally injured this morning within the terminal environment, an unfortunate incident that is regrettable. Operations were immediately suspended and preliminary investigations are underway. A board of enquiry will also be set-up to identify the root cause of the incident, which is still unknown at this stage. Employees on duty are receiving counselling and the terminal is in talks with the employer of the deceased. The South African Police Services have opened an inquest docket for further investigation. Operations remain suspended until all regulatory authorities currently onsite, conclude their assessments. The terminal and its leadership extend its condolences to the family of the deceased.
