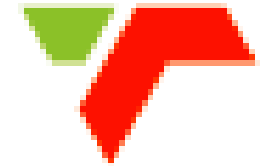

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TUBERCULOSIS

Symptoms:

- Persistent cough (more than 2-3 weeks) - usually with production of sputum.
- Coughing up blood.
- Fever and night sweats.
- Weight loss.
- Chest pains.
- Feeling weak and loss of appetite are sometimes also symptoms of TB.
- TB in HIV patients in advanced stages may present differently to TB in patients who are HIV-negative.

If you have any of these symptoms, or have come into contact with someone who may have TB, you must get tested for TB. Speak to your doctor, clinic or EAP representative. Getting tested and/or treated for TB is free
